Why does CEC offer a separate  
Call for Proposals for Teacher 2  
Teacher sessions?

CEC knows from the data we collect on the convention & expo from attendees that almost half of our attendees are classroom teachers—both special education and general education teachers—and almost 20 percent of the people who attend are studying to become teachers. So, these Teacher 2 Teacher sessions are our way of delivering quality content to this significant population of our attendees. To collect the latest and greatest ideas, a separate call, closer to the date of the convention is the best way to accomplish the goal.





How does this call differ from the general call for proposals that closed in March?

To begin with, the presenters must be current classroom teachers. We want these sessions to be hands-on, sharing-intensive sessions that will allow presenters to drill down into specific strategies and interventions that they've found to work in their own classrooms.

Educators love to share what they know and learn from one another. Teachers want to hear from their peers about what works and what doesn't.

# TEACHER APPEAL



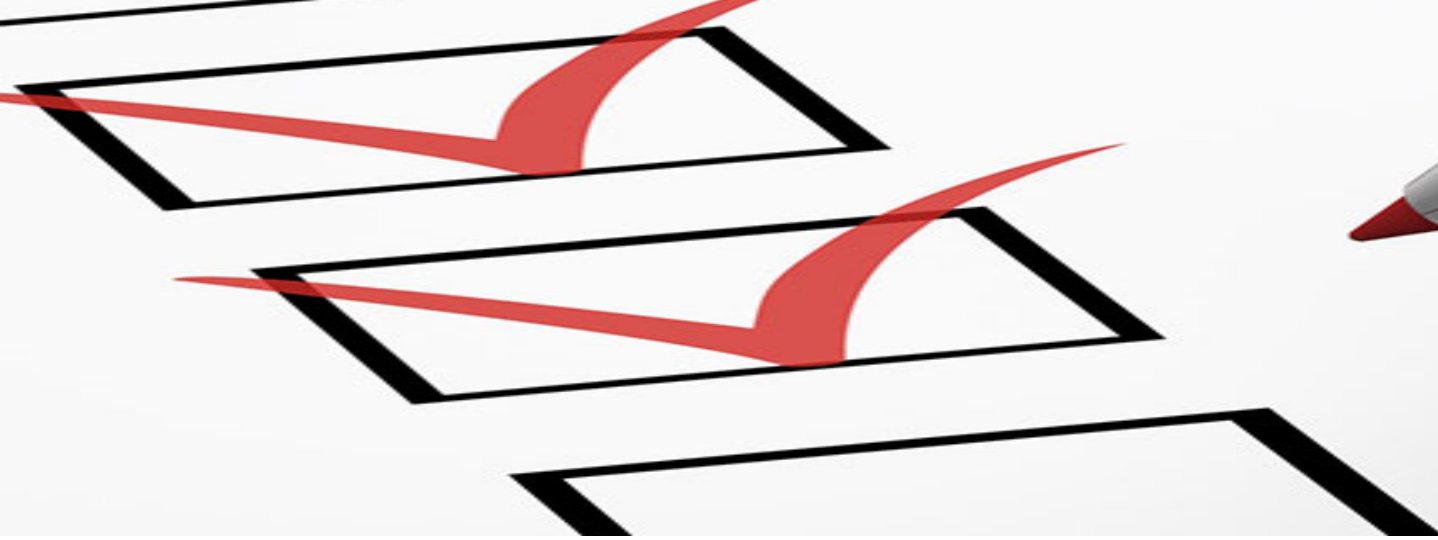
What are some of the other things that teachers are going to love about these sessions?

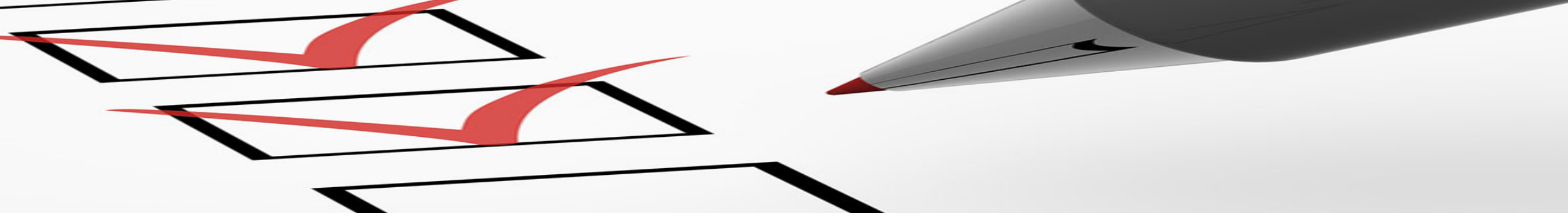

# REQUIREMENTS

Are there any requirements about what type of strategies, interventions, or tools can be presented?



CEC is always focused on research- and evidence-based practice. What this means is that all of the content of our convention is tried and true, that attendees walk away really understanding current best practices in the field. For Teacher2Teacher sessions, we are asking that the proposal include the evidence or research base for the material – whether it’s a tool, lesson plan, strategy, or intervention. This could be a broad-based literature review or rely on more targeted, focused research. It shouldn’t be based on anecdotes or what you think “might” work; there has to be evidence that the strategy has merit!



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# HOW DO YOU SUBMIT A TEACHER 2 TEACHER SESSION PROPOSAL?

# Let's quickly go over what information you will need to submit a proposal.

- Your contact information and bio (up to 100 words)
- Co-presenter contact information and bio (if applicable)
- Primary topic area (list provided)
- Session title (up to 12 words)
- Session description (up to 300 words)
- Learner outcomes (learning objectives; 3-4 outcomes that precisely describe the skills, knowledge, and/or behaviors that participants will know or be able to demonstrate)
- Target audience (list provided online)
